**Registration Fees** and all required completed registration forms (see Procedures check list) reserve a student's space at Smith Preparatory Academy. A student is considered enrolled once the student's completed registration forms have been submitted, the registration fee paid, and the Acceptance Letter sent. Every family pays a registration fee per year per student. **Registration fees are non-refundable. Registration after March 31 is \$500.00.**

**Tuition** covers the cost of books (except for elective and dual enrollment courses), curricular materials, classroom instruction, and other operational expenses at Smith Prep. In addition to tuition, families are required to purchase a school uniform as well as common school supplies, such as pens, pencils, and paper. Field Trips and extra curricular activities and events are not included with tuition and need to be paid separate.

A Smith Prep annual tuition includes following services: record keeping, curriculum counseling, standardized testing (grades 4-10), and/or portfolio review (grades K-3). High school tuition also includes: credit advising, diploma, graduation, transcripts, dual enrollment options, Florida Bright Futures and scholarship documentation.

Families may opt out of the services listed above and choose to only participate in Smith Prep classes. These students must be registered with the county or another private school. SPA will not hold academic records, provide academic advisement, or provide the services listed above. There is no tuition cost difference for opting out.

See website for day of week and class times. All classes meet for 32 weeks except for dual enrollment classes which meet for 18 weeks.

Tuition is due by July 1st. A \$100 Family Discount is offered to families who pay in full by May 15th.

**Credit verification** for Students new to Smith Prep entering 10th, 11th, or 12th Grades: Guidance will evaluate course work to verify that standards have been met and qualify for high school credit at SPA.

**Multiple Students:** Full tuition is charged for the first student. Each additional student from the same family will receive a \$200 discount.

\* **High School Seniors:** Senior Seminar Course is required for graduation. Base tuition includes 4 required courses that qualify for college credit and 1 elective. Additional book fees may apply.

^ **Elective courses** may required additional books not included with tuition.

+ **Latin/Math** are included in the comprehensive program tuition. Fees are for students not enrolled in our program.

**Refund Policy:** Application and enrollment fees are non-refundable. From time of registration, until the first week in June, we allow you to drop from classes or enrollment without penalty and tuition monies may be refunded. After enrollment closes in June, the balance for the entire school year is due, as teachers have been hired and classes confirmed with a fixed number of students.
